"The way of the wood is deep, not sitting on top, like paint on most support materials, but multi-layered in its growth. It is a fibrous being that take in washes of paint, sinking in at various levels of wood hardness and softness, giving me shapes and images from its grains. And through this give, I take its life in pulp and grains that formed during its creation, giving my subconscious mind, my life and spirit, answers from its life.



My process is similar to that of a burnt field that accepts a wind blown seed, growing life that seemingly meanders aimlessly into a fertile deathbed, but as Mother Earth shows us; complex in her breadth, mysterious in her form, beautiful in her outcome, she purposely creates in her own time from a plan that is intrinsically intuitive. My intent is that the viewer engage my work on all levels: physically, emotionally, intellectually and spiritually, that they would take away a bigger vision of themselves, as imagery and meanings unfold from this hybrid give and take of life."
